CAPABILITY STATEMENT *On the cargo's clock.*

AeroAcumen LLC is an owner-operated FAA Part 135 on-demand air carrier at Albuquerque Double Eagle II Airport (KAEG). We move small, time-critical shipments — Class 7 radioactive materials, short-lived medical isotopes, urgent laboratory and industrial-radiography sources, and AOG aircraft parts — dedicated and single-custody, day or night, on the shipment's schedule rather than a freight network's; on-demand passenger charter is available on the same aircraft. The company was founded and is flown by Prof. Erik Erhardt, PhD, a university brain-imaging researcher who built the carrier to solve the isotope-logistics problem he met in his own work: when the payload decays by the hour, a missed connection isn't a delay — it's a loss.

CORE COMPETENCIES

- **Time-critical air cargo** — dedicated same-day flights, urgent loads up to ~380 lb.
- **Class 7 radioactive materials** — will-carry authorized; DOT/IATA DGR trained and certified.
- **Medical isotopes & nuclear medicine** — short-lived imaging tracers (F-18, Tc-99m) on the decay clock.
- **Industrial radiography / NDT** — rapid source and equipment moves for source-down and decay-out emergencies.
- **AOG & aircraft-parts lift** — same-day hot-shot delivery for grounded aircraft.
- **On-demand passenger charter** — regional point-to-point on the same aircraft.
- **Single-custody handling** — one aircraft, one accountable pilot; no sort facilities, no interline handoffs.

WHAT SETS AEROACUMEN APART

- **Moves on the cargo's clock, not a network's** — flights depart when the shipment is ready.
